



Chris Tomlin — Sight Not Unseen

When you've created so many successful worship soundtracks sung the globe over, Chris Tomlin knows to keep his eyes firmly on his foundation—the cross

At the beginning of each of us, God places within our hearts the capacity to believe in what is unseen.

We call this faith.

At the same time, He blesses us with the ability to see beauty, love and grace in ways that are tangible—our children, the kindness of others...a song. Some call this grace—God's provision realized.

Among the many visceral elements that point to the great-unseen God of love, the most poignant and life altering is the cross.

When we cast our eyes to that terrible tree, we see the unimaginable, incomprehensible love and mercy that is our redemption, our freedom and, as **Chris Tomlin** says, our foundation.

"The idea of never losing sight of the cross has become so central to my life and all that I'm doing," says Tomlin. "The cross is the reason there is a church...it's the reason that there's anything. I hope to never lose sight of that and hope to remind people that even in the hardest of days, never lose sight because all things are possible." He doesn't have to search very hard in his own life for evidence of a limitless God. From the streets of tiny Grand Saline, Texas (pop. 3000—give or take), to the biggest arenas in the world, Tomlin's life is a case study in possibility. Touted as one of the most-sung songwriters in the world, he has topped nearly every musical chart there is, including *Billboard* 200 chart, making him only the fourth Christian artist to ever do so. He has won countless Dove Awards, Billboard Music Awards and a GRAMMY. He has also played an integral role in the cultural phenomenon **Passion**, which regularly sees over 60,000 college students come together for worship, discipleship and ministry.

But even more than the awards, the charts and the fans, Tomlin is seeing his God of the impossible at work fervently in his own home, namely in the blossoming lives of his daughters who are, in a word, strong.

"They're five and two now and they are both spitfires," Tonlin says with a knowing kind-of laugh every parent in the world can relate to. "They are beautiful little blond-hair girls and they are both so strong. You'd think you'll end up with one that is particularly strong, but they are both pretty strong girls. They can be sweet too," he adds in quickly, as if turning over a memory in his mind.

Not that there's a shortage of good times to pull from. Today, Tomlin's daily life revolves around a little royalty, a lot of glitter, all washed down with some chocolate milk.

"If I'm home, we'll do breakfast together. Eggs, bacon, cereal usually cereal. And chocolate milk, of course," Tomlin says, as if detailing an imaginary menu. "We'll go through about four or five princess outfits a day, with Dorothy usually in the mix as well. Whatever we play, that's who they are at the moment and that's what we call them." Be it Belle, Snow White or Dorothy, it is crystal clear that fatherhood has changed him in many ways. For one, there's new warmth in his laugh. There's also a new sense of unknown as he joins a league of parents wading with their kids through childhood, striving to make the right decisions, stumbling over humanity on the way—staying afloat on the words and promises of their own Heavenly Father, a name which has morphed into a new significance for Tomlin as of late. And it all started at bedtime...

"We love reading books to them," says Tomlin, referring also to his wife. "Putting them to bed is just the best. I've found the most peaceful thing in the world is when the kids are napping." With parents around the globe nodding their heads in agreement, he goes on. "Reading to the kids every day is really what started this whole good, good father thing," he says.

This whole "good, good father thing" is in reference, of course, to Tomlin's massive radio hit (which took away Song Of The Year at this year's Dove Awards), but also to the children's book he recently wrote alongside friend and colleague, **Pat Barrett**. That's right, as if he needed another item on his resume, Chris Tomlin is now a children's book author.

"The opening line of the song really started this idea in my head," he says. "It says, 'I've heard a thousand stories of what they think You're like.' This character began to form in my head of a little girl asking different people about what God is like. Eventually, that little girl became Tucker the bear, who sets out on a journey to see the King. Along the way, he hears that he's a doctor, a builder, all of these things. And when he arrives, of course, he realizes he is all those things, but above all, he is a good, good father." While most artists decide to write books on years in which they are not releasing an album, Tomlin goes to prove, once more, he is not most artists. The book came out just a few weeks apart from his latest project, *Never Lose Sight*, which released just weeks apart from a nation-wide movement Tomlin dreamed of and put together, called *Worship Night In America*. And wouldn't you know, after all of his albums and all of his conferences and events, his latest may be his most distinct and greatest ones yet.

Tomlin raises his own musical standard on his latest offering, partnering with a new producer, **Jeremy Edwardson**.

"So far, I've heard from lots of people that this album is so different from the others," Tomlin says. "At the end of the day, it's about one thing. The filter—is this accessible to the church? Most every song I write and produce, I want it to be so that anyone at any church could play it."

Once again, he's done just that. Before even hearing the songs a full-time through, listeners are already singing along, as if they've known them for years. Despite the accessibility, *Never Lose Sight* does showcase a different side and sound from Chris. His voice sounds fuller, warmer, as if mellowed a bit by life and all its happy challenges. Moreover, the lyrics, while easy to learn and grab onto, aren't necessarily obvious. Even after all these years and all these songs, Tomlin is still finding new ways to present the love and reality of God in a language that's as fresh as it is accessible.

Many of those songs took center stage at Chris's main-stage event, which brought the concept of corporate worship to a new level. On October 25, 2016 audiences in churches and theaters around the country came together to watch Chris and a bevy of the finest musicians and worship leaders in the worldPhil Wickham, Tasha Cobbs, Kim Walker-Smith, Matt Maher, Matt Redman, among others—joined forces with pastors and authors Max Lucado and Louie Giglio, for *Worship Night In America.* With every seat filled in Madison Square Garden, Tomlin and his team approached a nation that has been wracked by a tumultuous political environment and a season of divisiveness with a simple message.

"The goal is to pray for the nation," Tomlin simply states. "Prayer is greater than politics. In the midst of this time when things are so charged and there is so much uncertainty and unrest, it's time for the church to stand together and seek God, turn to Him and confess. It starts with us. It starts with our people."

Waving only the white flag of surrender to an almighty God, Chris Tomlin did on October 25, 2016 what he has been doing his entire career—humbling himself, turning to God and inviting the church to join him. Beyond that, this most decorated of artists generously took a backseat, sharing the stage, honoring the art of his colleagues.

His demeanor is not of the "most sung songwriter of all time," but continues to be that of many humbled by an awesome God; a father in love with his little girls and trying to figure out this thing called parenting; a husband committed to his home and family first; a sinner saved by grace.

His demeanor reflects his line of sight. He has removed distractions and set his eyes to rest daily upon the cross and upon the God who sacrificed His own Son. As Tomlin daily surrenders and commits to maintaining that view, he exemplifies for the rest of us how we can do the same and the kind of life—full, abundant, forgiven—we can all experience when, we too, never lose sight.

Don't Stop Believin' The faith journey of Jonathan Cain

As a 35-year member of **Journey**, **Jonathan Cain** could easily sit back and track the legendary band's nearly 90 million album sales and collect royalties from writing or co-writing "Don't Stop Believin'," "Faithfully," "Who's Crying Now" and "Open Arms" (to name a mere four of his many international hits). However the piano player, rhythm guitarist and sometimes singer (who also logged time in acclaimed power pop band **The Baby's** and hard rock super group **Bad English**) always stays relatively active as a solo artist, though when it comes to his brand new *What God Wants To Hear* (Identity Records), longtime listeners may be surprised to learn of a reignited spiritual quest.

While the Hollywood Walk Of Fame'r has always had faith in his life, he went through various seasons of doubt and uncertainty that originally stemmed from a childhood trauma, but were eventually ironed out by a seemingly chance meeting with **Pastor Paula White** on a flight. Not only did what he deemed to be a God-ordained conversation give the rock star enough divine fuel to refill his tank, but the pair became friends, eventually started dating and wound up getting married. Here's a closer look at the fascinating and inspirational turn of events, along with a deeper glimpse into the worshipful new album from an edited phone conversation between *CCM Magazine* and Cain.

CCM Magazine: Absolutely no pun intended here, but tell us about your faith journey throughout the years.

Jonathan Cain: I started out with a true love for Jesus when I was very young. My father was a very devout spiritual man who loved to pray and he was my mentor, really. He brought me into the Catholic church, kneeled me down and said, "I want you to pray to Jesus." "Who's Jesus?" "Well He's your savior." It was very matter-of-fact for him and I would watch him pray and I would be mesmerized by just how devout he was. He would go into this trance and these tears would come down and I would say, "Dad, are you crying?" "No, those are tears for Jesus." "Well I want those!" "You're not praying hard enough" (laughter). He said, "You've just gotta keep calling Him. He'll come." I went to Catholic school and I sang Gregorian chants in Latin in one of the most elite choirs we had in school. My first look at music was the Lord's music.

Then we had this terrible fire that hit our parish in 1958, Our Lady Of The Angels in Chicago, 100 children died and I just went distant with the Lord. When you're only eight-years old, you don't really understand the enemy very well, so I had a little numbing. But my dad gave me music and he said, "You were saved that day because the Lord has music in you and you're going to have some supernatural things happen in your life with music." He shipped me off to music lessons and was so certain that his son was going to be a star. I'll never forget it, that's truly a vision keeper right there! I was so blessed to have my dad. Even when I was a little angry of what happened with the fire, he kept covering over me and kept me in touch with the idea that God has saved me and I received that.

CCM: How did those mixed feelings land once adulthood hit?

JC: I sort-of had a breakthrough in an altar call in a Baptist church when I was about eighteen. So, some ten years later, I melted and had a breakthrough again. A pastor laid hands on me and that brought me back to the way of the Lord, so when my children were born, I was so thankful and wanted nothing more than to give them baptism and confirmation and some sort of structure with God. It was a Lutheran church, but my faith was still there.

[As the years went on], I was just kind of in and out of it, like a part-time Christian. My mind just wasn't there. I still had so many questions about what had really happened. It goes back to that fire, right back to that day. I was so shaken as a young boy that certainly God could've done something that day and He didn't. And I realized now that He was probably just as sad as we all were and I'm sure He cried with us that day.

Enter Paula [White]. I meet her on an airplane. We're on Southwest Airlines—you wouldn't think of Paula White and Journey on Southwest—but it was a random flight that we needed to get on to San Antonio, TX. We spoke together for two-and-a-half hours and she spoke into my heart like no woman had done before.

CCM: Did you know who each other were? It's probably not everyday where a famous rock star and a prominent pastor land next to each other on a plane!

JC: No, no, no! I just knew she was special. I didn't know what she did so I had to ask her. She said, "I wasn't going to tell you, but I'm a preacher." I said, "No way, hush up, you're a preacher?!" We shared our lives together on that flight. I was working on this memoir [right around then], so it was fresh on my mind



and I shared the story of the fire. She prophesied over me that the Lord wanted me. "Boy, that's funny you say that because I sure want my faith back. I want to feel like I did when I was seven-years old when I had that glow in my heart." She said, "He sure loves you," and that was it. She left that message and I didn't see her for a while, but then she came to a Journey show and prayed over me and we stayed friends. I'm an amateur photographer that takes nature shots and I'd send her pictures that I took to help her with some scripture for Facebook.

And then I got out of a bad marriage I was in. I was tied up in this marriage for too long, but I had three beautiful kids and my son had a little bout with drugs and rehab and her son had also been through it. I needed some direction as to how to turn with that, so I took immediate action and she helped me through that.

CCM: How did this meeting eventually evolve to dating and marriage?

JC: I asked her if she wanted a date [after my divorce]. You can't date a pastor too long, you know (laughter)? It doesn't always play good with the congregation, but we dated for a while and then she took me to Ghana and that's what shifted everything for me. The prayers in Ghana and Archbishop [Nicholas] Duncan-Williams, who is her spiritual father, had a profound effect on what I needed to do as a follower of Christ. "We've got work to do with you," he said, and I replied, "I know," and he gave me his prayer book and he showed me the prayers to pray.

They had these big prayer armies that were praying over Paula and I and it was like something out of a movie. Then I asked them to baptize me, so I went back for baptism, and I knew the next question was going to be, "Would you marry us?" So he did both. Archbishop was there and he married us and he baptized me and something shifted in me in a profound way. My big question was, "Am I good enough to be Paula White's husband?" I knew in my heart I was taking on a huge responsibility of being with a woman of God, of faith, who accepts His calling and he assured me that God had me. I said, "You let me know if you see any cracks in the armor." "Well there are some shaky things in there, but we're gonna pray them away." So he gave me the confidence to move forward, not only with my faith, and also with my marriage to Paula.

It's a story of restoration. I always loved Jesus so much. I just didn't know how to get back with Him. I wanted it, but when I moved here to Nashville, there were all these churches and I didn't know which one to go to. I didn't want to go to the wrong one and you always feel funny when you've been out of it for a while. It's hard going to a new church and attempting to fit in. But God wanted me to first meet Paula. It's funny because I never saw her preach for at least six months, and then I finally came to Orlando and her congregation welcomed me with open arms. I told them I was going to marry their pastor—they were thrilled and off we went. We had the little private wedding on a prayer mountain in Ghana with the Archbishop, then we came back and got married a year-and-a-half ago in April for the rest of the people, then I got married again back in church. For a guy that said he was never getting married again, I married Paula about three times!

CCM: The results of this remarkable rededication can be found all throughout What God Wants To Hear. What do you hope this album is going to do for folks who share your faith and also for those who have different beliefs?

JC: Here's my thing. [I hope] I can make their walk with God a little bit closer and maybe attract somebody back to the Lord

or who hasn't thought about God in a while. I had some people come over every now and then when I was recording the album and some were saying, "Man, that moved me, I haven't actually had a song make me think of God that way." Ah-ha! If I have one person that happens to, then I've done my job. That's my hope that it can minister to people and bring them closer to God, to the Word, and to the Kingdom.

CCM: How familiar have you been with contemporary Christian music? Are there any artists that you've especially come to like over the years, or is this sort-of a new entrance for you?

JC: It's kind-of a new entrance. People always would compare me to Michael W. Smith over the years, and when I put out my [mainstream solo albums], they said I sounded like him. So I looked him up and said, "Wait a minute, he sounds like me!" The piano sounded like Journey and there are a lot of similarities in our style. Also, I was always a huge fan of Andraé Crouch. I thought he had an amazing career, but other than that, not a lot. I also realized that a lot of the '60s soul music and rock n' roll came out of church. A lot of the great singers of the soul era were trained in church and you can hear it.

CCM: What were your musical and lyrical goals with this new project?

JC: I wanted to just have an intimate encounter with God musically and not get a bunch of co-writers and ideas and bang them around and do all of that because this is just my walk with God. I wanted to keep it on an intimate level, pure with only the words that He gave me. And it was a different kind of album for me because it came with the lyrics first. I'm used to writing the music and finding a lyric that fits. In this case, it was all dictation that I was just taking down, and it was coming weekly

[faster than ever]. Soon, I had enough to start doing a praise and worship album, so Paula gave me a Sunday or two to perform them. I called [former Journey drummer] **Deen Castronovo**, who's out of rehab and finding the Lord again, and we started singing in church.

I wanted to keep my style in it, but I also wanted to be true to the Word and not water it down with any fluffy stuff like, "Let's be vague and write a love song, but we don't know who it's to the word 'God' is no where to be found, but it's about God, trust us!" Okay, what is that? I'm old school, so I don't quite get that. I understand it's probably a millennial thing, maybe that's what they're going for, but that's not what I'm about. The Bible's just full of such great stuff. There's even a song called "Sanctify," and most Christians won't even say the word "sanctification." That's like, almost taboo—why? It shouldn't be. Through justification, we are sanctified. I like the word, I thought it sounded cool, and I made a rock song for Jesus out of it. There it is, sue me (laughter)! If people want to come out and judge me because of my love for the Lord and my sowing into the Kingdom, then they've only got one Person to answer to. I ain't going away, and this is the first of many. I hope to maybe have some of these songs get sung in church by other bands and I hope to leave this music to be a lasting legacy as my love for God.

CCM: What do the rest of the Journey guys think of your current musical and personal direction?

JC: Um, I don't know. I think they pretty much stay in their lane with that. They know I had a profound shift in my life. I needed to change. I wasn't happy. They see me smile and they see me a different guy out there on stage. They know that much and they respect it. They respect what I'm doing.

CCM: Would you ever incorporate spirituality into your song-writing with the band?

JC: No, no. Journey's Journey. It will always be. It always has an identity. This music also has its identity and it has its truth. My job as a steward of the music is to keep the truth and identity pure, so no, I would not co-mingle. But I certainly would like to get back into production and hopefully my studio [Addiction Sound in Nashville] can be a new beacon on the hill for Christian music, and maybe this label [Identity Records] that I'm starting can make some waves. I've been inspired by what the Jesus Culture people have done. Kim Walker-Smith is a friend of ours and what she's been able to accomplish is just amazing. If the Lord's opening doors like that, then I'm gonna keep knockin.



Natalie Grant — Her Real Voice

Almost two decades, dozens of albums and books published, several millions of them sold—Natalie Grant has finally found her real voice

Toward the end of last year, the Dec. 1, 2015 *CCM Magazine* cover artist **Natalie Grant** had just released the album *Be One*, and was happy to share with us the shifts in her life that have paved the way to newfound freedoms.

Nearly one year later, the iconic vocalist is not only still talking, she's writing about them, too. With the release of her new book, *Finding Your Voice: What Every Woman Needs To Live Her God-Given Passions Out Loud* (Zondervan, Sep. 13, 2016), Grant is furthering her message to help people discover what she herself is discovering—their own unique God-given gifts and the confidence to rise above deceitful fears for living their calling, as she emphatically states it, "out loud!"

Despite her foray into adding the "author" tag to her wellaccomplished resume (which touts an impressive lineup of titles through the years, even incorporating her three kids to contribute to *Glimmer Girls*, a themed series of children's/ pre-teen books for girls), Grant will be the first to tell you that she's nowhere close to having "arrived." What she will tell—in addition to God's truths—is that you indeed have a voice, and now that she's living into hers (singing, writing, or just being a mom) from a God-breathed perspective, she's leading the cheer for the launch or rebirth of our own voices. It's seems a little strange to say it at first, but multiple awardswon and millions of albums sold later, Grant has truly, and finally, found her voice. We got the chance to talk with her a little more in-depth about the real meaning behind all of this in our latest interview.

CCM Magazine: Take us back to the beginning, if you can, of the things brought on, to use on of your quotes, "suffocating inadequacy." As you were going through all of that, where did you go to find God's strength? In what ways did He reveal His abundance to you that you may/or perhaps may not have expected?

Natalie Grant: Through the years it manifested itself in different ways—to having an eating disorder which stemmed from a feeling of inadequacy, to postpartum depression which stemmed from a feeling of inadequacy as a mother...so many... But there's an underlying theme to every one of those, and that's that feeling of, "I just don't measure up," or, that somehow, and especially for me, that feeling of needing to keep up with my appearance. But, I actually *did* have it all together, when, in fact, underneath I felt like I was crumbling from the pressure of it all.

I can easily say, "Oh, I found my strength in God's Word..." At different times throughout that process, yes, that was true. But I think it was specifically at a time where the Word of God became real to me in a way like it never had before. I began to see myself in [biblical] characters that I had read about my entire life. From people who doubted and had insecurities... In fact, it seems like the ones that God used the most powerfully were those who had similar struggles to mine.

When you discover that's actually the way that God does His best work is through our inadequacies, it proves that, "in our weakness His strength is made perfect." It's one thing to read that, it's another thing to begin to experience, "Okay, instead of fighting this weakness—instead of fighting that feeling of inadequacy—embracing it ... I'm going to dive in an allow that, just immerse my self in it, knowing that in that I'm going to find the strength of God and it's going to be greater than my own feeling of inadequacy."

I think that we have to allow those things to become real to us. I think so often we ask God to do something for us. Like, "God, please help me. God, please do 'this.' God, please do 'that.'" What I'm really discovering is that we have more responsibility [on us] than we want to take—not like a "works-salvation," I don't mean that—what I mean is that He's already done everything He needs to do in order to get us out of the pit. He is still extending His hand, but we have to take ahold of it. We have to take ahold of the hand that's extended and by faith, believe that what He was says is true. I think that was the turning point for me.

CCM: We recently talked to former By The Tree front man Chuck Denny...

NG: Oh, yeah! He was my campus pastor for a while...

CCM: He went through some very similar struggles and processes. It made me wonder if this kind of "inadequacy" is more prevalent today because we are so bombarded with always having to measure up to looking perfect on social media, etc. Do you think that plays a part of it?

NG: I think it's a huge part of it, and I think, also, for those of us that are really struggling that are in a full time "ministry capacity," whether it's in music or pastoral ministry or those of us who are on a stage where Jesus is our platform, I think it's a deeper

conversation. It wasn't intentional, but from my own experience, human nature and our flesh can still become a part of it that desire to succeed and to be good at what we're doing. Then, you mix that together with ministry—which will never exist together—and eventually that flesh side is going to come crashing down and we are going to realize that we are inadequate because, even though we said, "We are putting our strength and focus in the Lord," it's really hard to finally come to the place where you can truthfully admit that.

Even in ministry, we measure our own success not by what God deems as successful, but we measure it against what other people are doing in ministry. The devil is sneaky, I'm telling you! He's sneaky and even in our best intentions, even in those intentions to do those things that are absolutely full of God, he sneaks in—even in the smallest of ways—and uses that comparison trap in every area of life and it's so destructive.

I was putting a lot of eggs in the basket of talent, the basket of my influence...eggs in the basket of my "whatever." You have to come to grips with that, and I think you often see that because in ministry you have to come to the end of yourself. If you don't, eventually you are just going to crash and burn a little bit harder. I only know that from personal experience! Even those who are not in ministry, with the growth of social media, etc. ... I think about the struggles of inadequacy I had when I was growing up, yet I wasn't bombarded every single day like today's culture.

CCM: One of the things that Dennie said that I thought was kind-of profound was, "I know God and He knows me, and He's perfecting me everyday."

NG: That's incredible, right?

CCM: As you were going through this discovery, what were some of the things that were going on inside of you that you have eventually given a voice to? Maybe it's one of the topics in your new book, or something that that sticks out in particular?

NG: I think for me, one of the things I've really come to terms with over the last couple of years—and I do write about it in the book, because it's where so many of my struggles stem from and that's fear. I really struggle with fear. Everybody knows that I'm afraid to fly because I post about it on social media all the time, because it's a real tangible struggle. The truth is, I struggle with fear in just about every aspect of my life.

I can't necessarily speak to men because I am not one, but ... well, I think men [also struggle] but it just manifests itself in different ways—like throwing yourself into your work [for example]. So many men are workaholics because of that underlying fear of failing.

I can trace almost every struggle back to a fear of failure, or a fear of [whatever] ... The fear of wondering if my kids are going to be screwed up, or if I just take one step to the right or one step to the left, I'm going to screw everything up. Most of it actually still stems from this idea that we can control our lives—with "this" and with "that," we can control the outcome. I think that letting go of the idea that I'm actually in control and, instead, embracing [our inadequacies] is just what it means to trust and to have faith. I talk about that many times throughout the book.

CCM: Specifically, how do you encourage other women who don't have the type of platform that you have into using their strengths, their voices for God's glory?

NG: First, every single one of us has a voice. [We must] break the cycle of that "comparison trap," that, "But, I won't do—but, I won't be." I think it's really about discovering the God given passion that He has put into your heart and life and realizing that if it is from God, all the things that we think disqualify us or sideline us or will never come to pass...those are just the things that the Father of Lies uses to keep us silent.

I was talking about this just last night. So often we want to point to a circumstance or a situation that has silenced us, right? Like, "Oh, it was a bad marriage...it was this, that, or the other. It's my own mistake, my shame, my childhood, my 'something' that has silenced me." But the truth is that the only one who can silence the song that God has put into every single one of our souls is ourselves.

When we can realize, "Okay, these things were done to me, but I actually I have the power because of Christ living in me—I actually do have the strength and the power to rise above that and to let my voice rise above the brokenness." I think that when we begin to take responsibility, it begins to actually break down the hurt and the wrong—the holds that can have. When you realize, "Okay, I'm not looking to raise my voice because I need a platform. I'm looking to raise my voice because when I do, my life will begin to soar on God's melody. It's the thing that will help me rise above the broken pieces of my life." I think that whatever comes along with that, is an incredible benefit, but it's God's glory. It's Him receiving glory through us rising above the broken work. That's where He likes to shine the brightest.

CCM: You, in particular, are a singer and the book title does have the word "voice" in it, so how has going through this spiritual process seeped into your music?

NG: It has definitely influenced it. But first and foremost, what I have really realized over the last few years is that singing is what I do, it's not who I am. I think that so often, whatever it is that we do—whatever it is that we are gifted at, whatever it is that comes easy to us—it becomes our identity. Through this process I've really discovered more power in discovering *whose* I am, daughter of the King, chosen, beloved, cherished, valued [by Him]. I kind-of foolishly thought singing made me those things. It doesn't. It's just a way to tell the truth with a gift that I did nothing for but that He gave me. Discovering that has drastically changed my songwriting, the things that I sing, and the way I go about it all.

When you come to see me in a show, you realize that I'm not going out to be an entertainer—and I don't think there's anything wrong with that, I really don't. I think it's amazing if [entertaining is] your gifting, but it's not mine. My gifting is to be a truthteller and I think that one of the greatest gifts that He has given me is an ability to connect with people. My music is what brings them to the table, but I think honesty, genuine transparency, and an openness about my insecurities, fears and struggles is what keeps them there.

I also think it's where they begin to discover who Christ is through my life, not just through my music. I know that's not exactly answering what you asked, but it is in the sense that it's playing itself out in my music and my art because the development of who I am as an artist has become so much more than the music. Does that make sense?

CCM: Absolutely. ...and, you are one of the few artists that truly and honestly opens up the door, even to your own home.

NG: Right.


CCM: If anyone reading follows you on social media, that is very obvious right away.

NG: [chuckles]

CCM: Which leads me to my last question: We've heard and seen how your kids have been involved in the recording process of your music, but what have they taught you in the process of writing this book? How has being a mom influenced you as an author?

NG: They're throughout the book because so much of my struggle and fear comes from thoughts of failing them. I have two incredible parents that have done so much for me, but it was a different generation, you know? One of the things I didn't see a lot was my parents embracing their weaknesses. [On one hand] we don't want to, because we want to believe our dad is Superman, but I think one of the things that I've really been intentional about is actually being weak in front of my kids. When I fail them, when I lose my temper with them—which is way too often than I want to admit—I apologize. I go to them and say, "I am wrong. I made a mistake. I shouldn't have done that." I think that what a child has is that immediate ability to receive you in your weakness, to love you anyway and look past it.

We lose that the older we get. We become jaded. We might say, "we forgive," but we carry it. We tuck it away somewhere on the inside and don't forget. Kids still have that ability to just be like, "It's okay, Mom. Of course you make mistakes. Of course you're going to do that. That's okay. That's okay." I think we lose that. It does take courage to let your weaknesses show, but if you start by actually letting your kids in on them, the amount of conversation and the amount of trust that is built (and what you will receive from them) will just be immeasurable, honestly. I can tell you, that so much strength comes to me through being weak in front of my kids, and what they give me as a result of that is really truly beautiful. $\Box\Box M$
